10th Annual IIDA Calibre Award Winners 1998

The IIDA Calibre Awards were founded ten years ago to honor companies who exhibit or support a high standard of quality design over time. In honor of this milestone, ten awards were given, the largest number ever presented. The nominees must not only have supported the effort to increase public awareness of design, but also have demonstrated concern and support for quality design on an ongoing basis.

This year, the nomination process was augmented by a request for candidates from Professional and Associate IIDA members. The Nominations Committee contributed candidates as well, and selected the final nominees after validating the qualifications of the names submitted.

Herman Miller generously hosted the nomination reception and ballot at their Los Angeles showroom, where IIDA Professional and Associate members cast ballots for the winners. For the first time, the five City Centers were provided with videos of the nominees, taken at the LA event, and voted at their own holiday parties. All of the nominees are outstanding candidates for the Calibre Award.

Civic Award City of Los Angeles

Under the leadership of William A. Holland, AIA, City Architect, Los Angeles has compiled an impressive group of recent building projects totaling \$100,000,000 in budgeted funds. Among these are twentyeight new branch libraries, nine police departments, a major build-out of historic City Hall East and improvements in City-owned Civic Center buildings and San Pedro municipal buildings.

Other outstanding projects include the Japanese Garden at Tillman Water Reclamation Plant, Sepulveda Basin; the Central Library restoration and expansion, the Convention Center expansion, a master plan for the Civic Center and the 10 Minute Diamond Study. Holland has created a Sustainable Design Manual and numerous design awards have been bestowed in the process. Utilizing the talents of many designers and architects, the City of Los Angeles has laid a broad foundation of quality design upon which to build the future.

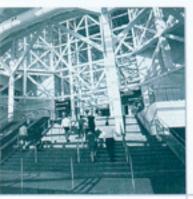
